**Pre-registration deadline for voter registration** closes at 5:00 p.m. Saturday, October 24, 2020. Persons wishing to participate in this election who register to vote after October 24, 2020 will be required to provide proof of identification (i.e. current and valid photo identification card with an expiration date), AND proof of residency in their voting precinct, when they go to the polls on election day, or when they request an absentee ballot. Other provisions may also apply. Persons not registered to vote by October 24, 2020 should expect a longer processing time at the polls on election day.

**Absentee Ballots** will be available beginning Monday, October 5, 2020.

- The last day an absentee ballot may be mailed to a voter for this election is Saturday, October 24, 2020.
- In-person absentee voting in the office of the Jones County Auditor closes at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 2, 2020.
- Requests for absentee ballots must be in writing and should be mailed or delivered to:
  - Jones County Auditor, 500 W. Main St., Anamosa IA 52205
  - Request forms are available at the following locations:
    - Jones County Auditor's Office
    - Jones County Election web-site: [www.jonescountyiowaelections.gov](http://www.jonescountyiowaelections.gov)
    - In lieu of the form, voters may submit their request on a piece of paper no smaller than 3" x 5" containing the following information: Voter's name, birth date, ID number (i.e. drivers' license number, non-operator ID number, or voter PIN number), address in Jones County (and mailing address-if different), brief statement requesting an absentee ballot for the 2020 General Election, and the voter's signature. A telephone number is recommended, but not required. Missing information will delay the issuance of the ballot.
    - Absentee ballot request forms are expected to be mailed to all active registered voters in the State of Iowa by the Iowa Secretary of State in late August, 2020 to the address on the voter's registration record.
    - Ballots may not be mailed to persons who are not registered to vote by October 24, 2020.
